Toscana Aeroporti reminds that shareholders may only participate in the Ordinary Shareholders' Meeting by granting proxy authorisation to the Designated Representative, identified as Computershare S.p.A. pursuant to Article 135-undecies of the Consolidated Law on Finance (TUF), without participation in the proceedings of any other vote-holder or physical presence of any individual shareholders.

Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. is the management company of the Florence and Pisa airports. Founded on 1 June 2015 through the merger of AdF - Aeroporto di Firenze S.p.A.
