JANUARY 2024: TUSCAN AIRPORT SYSTEM'S PASSENGER TRAFFIC UP +8.6% COMPARED TO 2023 Florence airport's best January ever

Florence, February 9, 2024 – The Tuscan Airport System handled over 460,000 passengers overall in January 2024, up +8.6% on January 2023. The passenger traffic increase was driven by the rise both in the number of total flights (+6.0% compared to January 2023) and in the load factor (i.e., the percentage of available seating capacity filled with passengers), which rose by over 2 percentage points compared to January 2023, increasing from 79.0% to 81.2%.

Florence Amerigo Vespucci airport

With almost 195,000 passengers, Florence airport reported an all-time record for January, with a +32.4% rise compared to 2023. The increase was attributable to the performance in terms of total flights (+20.4%) and of the load factor (78.0%; +4.7 pps). Traffic grew both in the national (+123.5%) and international (+23.4%) segments. The most popular destinations among Florence airport's passengers in January 2024 were Paris, Amsterdam, Rome, London and Barcelona.

Pisa Galileo Galilei airport

With over 265,000 passengers handled in January 2024, Pisa airport's passenger traffic declined by 4.1% compared to the same month of 2023. This change was due to the decrease in the number of total flights for the period (-6.9%), partly offset by the load factor increase to 83.7% (+1.2 pps). In detail, the increase in international scheduled traffic (+5.6%) partially offset the decline in the national component (-19.6%). The ranking of the most popular destinations in January 2024 included Tirana, London, Palermo, Catania and Paris.
