## TOSCANA AEROPORTI'S BoD ON THE COUNCIL OF STATE JUDGEMENTS

Florence, February 20, 2020 – The Board of Directors of Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A., convened today under the chairmanship of Marco Carrai, acknowledged and examined the content of the judgements of the Council of State rejecting the appeals lodged by, inter alia, Italy's Ministry of the Environment and Protection of the Land and Sea, Italy's Ministry of Cultural Heritage and Activities, the Italian Civil Aviation Authority (ENAC), the Municipality of Florence, the Region of Tuscany, the Metropolitan City of Florence and Toscana Aeroporti against the judgement of the Regional Administrative Court of Tuscany No. 723 of 2019.

Fully aware of the Florence airport's need to construct a new runway and a new terminal to remedy the airport's evident critical infrastructure concerns — as also highlighted today by the Italian Civil Aviation Authority (ENAC) in its letter where it requires that the analysis, study and design activities be launched, thereby confirming its interest in the construction of the new runway —, the Board of Directors resolved to take the necessary steps to move forward with the proceedings concerning the Florence airport's Master Plan.
