

PRESS RELEASE**Tuscan Airport System hits record passenger traffic numbers:
April 2024 marks a new all-time high**

Florence, May 3, 2024 – The Tuscan Airport System hit a new record in **April 2024**, with over 810 thousand passengers handled overall by Florence and Pisa airports, up +12.0% compared to the same month of 2023. This result was mainly driven by the +10.2% increase in total passenger flights compared to 2023, which more than offset the decline of 0.4 percentage points in the load factor¹ (82.9%).

The **first four months of the year** also recorded an all-time high, with nearly 2.3 million passengers handled, up +13.2% compared to the same period of 2023.

Florence Amerigo Vespucci airport continued to grow, with a new monthly record. With nearly 319 thousand passengers handled, Florence airport reported its best April ever, up by +19.5% on April 2023. The number of flights rose (+7.6% on 2023), as did the load factor (+0.3 percentage points to 79.2%). In detail, April saw an increase in both national scheduled traffic (+54.9%) and international traffic (+15.5%) compared to the same month of 2023. The five most appreciated destinations among Florence airport's passengers in April 2024 were Paris, Amsterdam, London, Barcelona and Munich.

Passenger traffic at April 30, 2024 hit a record in each individual month, allowing Florence airport to reach a total of 944 thousand passengers, up +26.5% compared to 2023.

Pisa Galileo Galilei airport recorded an all-time high in the month and the best April ever, with 492 thousand passengers handled and a +7.6% increase compared to the same month of 2023. This result was driven by the +12.9% increase in total passenger flights, which more than offset the decline of 0.5 percentage points in the load factor (85.5%). Pisa airport grew sharply in April in terms of international scheduled traffic (+13.5%), whereas national traffic declined (-8.8%). The most popular destinations among passengers were London, Tirana, Catania, Paris and Palermo.

In the first four months of 2024, passengers handled by Pisa airport amounted to nearly 1.4 million, up +5.5% compared to the same period of 2023.

Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. is the management company of the Florence and Pisa airports. Founded on 1 June 2015 through the merger of AdF - Aeroporto di Firenze S.p.A. (managing company of the Florence A. Vespucci airport) and SAT - Società Aeroporto Toscano S.p.A. (managing company of the Pisa G. Galilei Airport), Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. stands out for the complementary nature of the two airports, each with its own specific features: Florence airport focuses on the development of business and leisure traffic through full-service carriers, linking the major European hubs; whereas Pisa airport focuses mainly on tourism traffic operated by low-cost carriers and on cargo flights, paying particular attention to intercontinental connections. The Tuscan Airport System is one of the most important in Italy and is a driver of local economic development in one of the world's best known and most loved regions.
