

PRESS RELEASE**November 2024 marks a new passenger record**
Exceeded 2023 total passengers already in November

Florence, December 3, 2024 – Another record month for the **Tuscan Airport System**, which reached a total of 555,000 passengers transited through the Florence and Pisa airports in November, up 15.2% compared to the same month in 2023. Both the increase in commercial passenger flight movements (+9.3%) and the load factor of scheduled flights, which stood at 84.3% (+3.1 percentage points), contributed to the positive results for the month. **Already exceeded in November the total number of passengers transited in 2023.** In fact, as of November 30, 2024, there are about 8.5 million total passengers transited, a growth of 10.4% over 2023.

Best November ever for Florence's Amerigo Vespucci airport, with 237,000 passengers transited and a 14.4% increase over 2023. Both the number of commercial passenger flights (+10.8%) and the aircraft load factor improved to 80.9% (+1.7 percentage points) compared to 2023. The month is characterized by significant growth in both domestic (+17.7%) and international (+13.7%) passenger traffic. The month's ranking of favourite destinations served by direct flights sees Paris in first place, followed by London, Barcelona, Rome and Amsterdam. With monthly records recorded in every single month of the year, Florence Airport reaches 3.3 million passengers as of November 30, 2024, a growth of 14.7% compared to the same period in 2023.

Pisa's Galileo Galilei airport marks a record November, with 317,000 passengers passing through and a 15.8% increase over the same month in 2023. Improved load factor (+4.2 percentage points) at 87.0% and commercial passenger flight movements (+7.6%) contributed positively to the results achieved in November. In addition, both domestic (+35.9%) and international (+9.4%) commercial traffic grew strongly during the month. London is confirmed at the top of the list of favourite destinations for passengers at the Pisa airport, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Bari. Pisa Airport reaches 5.2 million passengers in the first eleven months of the year, marking its best ever result for the period, with a 15.8% increase over 2023.
