**The record series continues for Toscana Aeroporti
More than 980 thousand passengers transited in May (+10.2%)**

Florence, June 4, 2025 - Toscana Aeroporti exceeded the 900 thousand passenger threshold for the first time in May, with a total of 981 thousand passengers passing through the Florence and Pisa airports and a 10.2% improvement on 2024. Both the domestic (+15.4%) and international (+9.6%) commercial traffic segments grew in May. Overall traffic for the first 5 months of the year was 3.5 million passengers, up 10.5% on the same period in 2024 and confirming the best results ever in every single month of the year.

Florence's 'Amerigo Vespucci' airport recorded its best May ever with 390,000 passengers passing through and 10.3% growth over the same month in 2024. The strong positive change in the international commercial traffic segment (+14.0%) more than offset the drop in the domestic segment (-11.3%). An all-time daily record for the Florentine airport, which on May 4, 2025 exceeded 14 thousand transiting passengers. The most popular destinations in May for passengers at the Florentine airport were Paris, London, Amsterdam, Barcelona and Munich. In the first five months of the year, Florence airport exceeded 1.4 million passengers, an improvement of 9.2% over the same period in 2024.

Pisa's "Galileo Galilei" airport continued its record streak by exceeding 591 thousand passengers in May and an increase of 10.1% over 2024. The positive result was driven by the strong increase in both the domestic (+27.4%) and international (+6.5%) commercial traffic segments. In May, London was confirmed as the route most used by passengers at Pisa airport, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Brussels. The Pisa airport has already surpassed the threshold of 2 million total transiting passengers in the first five months of 2025, registering growth of 11.4% compared to the same period in 2024.
