RECORD JULY AND STRONG GROWTH IN THE FIRST SEVEN MONTHS OF 2025

The Tuscan Airport System exceeded one million passengers in July (+6.6%) and reached 5.6 million since the beginning of the year (+9.1%)

Florence, August 5, 2025 - Toscana Aeroporti closed July 2025 with a new traffic record, handling a total of 1.1 million passengers at Florence and Pisa airports. This figure represents an increase of +6.6% compared to the same month in 2024. This result was supported by the solid performance of both segments: international traffic grew by +5.8%, while domestic traffic accelerated by +8.7%.

In the first seven months of 2025, total traffic reached a record 5.6 million passengers, an increase of +9.1% compared to the same period in 2024.

Performance of individual airports:

Florence 'Amerigo Vespucci' airport (FLR): the Florentine airport recorded its **best July ever** with 385,000 passengers, up +9.9% compared to 2024. Growth was driven mainly by the strong acceleration in international traffic (+12.4%), which offset the slight decline in domestic traffic (-3.3%). The five busiest destinations for the month were, in order, Paris, London, Amsterdam, Munich and Barcelona. Since the beginning of the year, 2.2 million passengers have passed through Florence, an increase of +9.3% compared to 2024.

Pisa's "Galileo Galilei" airport (PSA): Pisa airport also closed a record month, marking the **best month ever in the airport's history** with 681,000 passengers (+4.8% vs July 2024). Performance was positive in both markets, with international traffic up +1.9% and the domestic segment expanding strongly (+13.4%). The busiest routes in July were London, Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Cagliari. Traffic since the beginning of the year reached a record 3.4 million passengers, an improvement of +8.9% compared to the first seven months of 2024.

Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. is the management company of the Florence and Pisa airports. Founded on 1 June 2015 through the merger of AdF - Aeroporto di Firenze S.p.A. (managing company of the Florence A. Vespucci airport) and SAT - Società Aeroporto Toscano S.p.A. (managing company of the Pisa G. Galilei Airport), Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. stands out for the complementary nature of the two airports, each with its own specific features: Florence airport focuses on the development of business and leisure traffic through full-service carriers, linking the major European hubs; whereas Pisa airport focuses mainly on tourism traffic operated by low-cost carriers and on cargo flights, paying particular attention to intercontinental connections. The Tuscan Airport System is one of the most important in Italy and is a driver of local economic development in one of the world's best known and most loved regions.
