THE RECORD TREND OF THE TUSCAN AIRPORT SYSTEM CONTINUES: OVER ONE MILLION PASSENGERS ALSO IN AUGUST (+6.7%)

Since the beginning of the year, 6.7 million passengers have been reached (+8.7%)

Florence, September 5, 2025 - Toscana Aeroporti exceeded the one million passenger threshold for the third consecutive month, setting a new all-time monthly record. In August 2025, the Florence and Pisa airports recorded 1.1 million passengers, marking a +6.7% increase compared to August 2024. This result was supported by the positive performance of both the international (+6.6%) and domestic (+7.2%) traffic segments. Total traffic for the first eight months of the year reached 6.7 million passengers, an improvement of +8.7% compared to the same period in 2024.

Performance of individual airports:

Florence's Amerigo Vespucci airport had its **best August ever** with 385,000 passengers, an increase of 8.4% compared to 2024. This performance was mainly driven by international traffic (+10.5%), which more than offset the slight decline in domestic traffic (-3.5%). The busiest routes for passengers departing from Florence airport were, in order: Paris, London, Amsterdam, Barcelona and Munich. The first eight months of 2025 were a record for Florence airport, with more than 2.5 million passengers passing through and an improvement of +9.2% compared to 2024.

Pisa's Galileo Galilei airport recorded its **best month ever** with 686,000 passengers, an increase of +5.8% compared to August 2024. Growth was driven by the positive performance of both market segments: international (+4.3%) and domestic (+11.3%). London remains the busiest route from Pisa airport, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Brussels. Progressive traffic exceeded the 4 million passenger threshold for the first time in August. In fact, 4.1 million passengers passed through the airport, an increase of +8.4% compared to the first eight months of 2024.

Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. is the management company of the Florence and Pisa airports. Founded on 1 June 2015 through the merger of AdF-Aeroporto di Firenze S.p.A. (managing company of the Florence A. Vespucci airport) and SAT-Società Aeroporto Toscano S.p.A. (managing company of the Pisa G. Galilei Airport), Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. stands out for the complementary nature of the two airports, each with its own specific features: Florence airport focuses on the development of business and leisure traffic through full-service carriers, linking the major European hubs; whereas Pisa airport focuses mainly on tourism traffic operated by low-cost carriers and on cargo flights, paying particular attention to intercontinental connections. The Tuscan Airport System is one of the most important in Italy and is a driver of local economic development in one of the world's best known and most loved regions.
