## **TUSCANY AIRPORT SYSTEM:**

# RECORD SEPTEMBER WITH ALMOST 1 MILLION PASSENGERS (+7.0%) Since the beginning of the year, over 7.6 million passengers (+8.5%)

Florence, October 2, 2025 - Toscana Aeroporti, a company listed on Euronext Milan of the Italian Stock Exchange that manages the airports of Florence and Pisa, set a new monthly record in September 2025, reaching nearly one million passengers. In fact, a total of 995,000 passengers passed through the two airports of Florence and Pisa, representing an increase of +7.0% compared to September 2024. The positive performance of both traffic segments contributed to this record result: international (+8.8%) and domestic (+1.5%). Total traffic for the first nine months of 2025 confirms the growth trend for the year, exceeding 7.6 million passengers and an increase of +8.5% compared to the same period in 2024.

## **Performance of individual airports:**

**Florence's Amerigo Vespucci airport**, in September 2025, recorded its **best month ever**, with 395,000 passengers and growth of +11.7% compared to September 2024. It also set a **new daily record**, exceeding 15,000 passengers on September 7, 2025. The strong positive change in international traffic (+16.2%) more than offset the decline in domestic traffic (-14.2%). The ranking of the busiest routes for passengers at Florence airport is as follows: Paris, London, Amsterdam, Barcelona and Munich. Total traffic at Florence airport for the first nine months of the year, marked by records in every single month, reached almost 3 million passengers, an increase of +9.5% compared to the same period in 2024.

**Pisa's Galileo Galilei airport** recorded its **best September ever** with 600,000 passengers passing through, an increase of +4.1% compared to September 2024. Both market segments contributed to the month's growth: international (+3.8%) and domestic (+7.9%). In September, London remained the most popular destination for passengers travelling from Pisa airport, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Cagliari. As of September 30, 2025, 4.7 million passengers had passed through Pisa airport, an increase of +7.8% compared to the same period in 2024.

**Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A.** is the management company of the Florence and Pisa airports. Founded on 1 June 2015 through the merger of AdF - Aeroporto di Firenze S.p.A. (managing company of the Florence A. Vespucci airport) and SAT - Società Aeroporto Toscano S.p.A. (managing company of the Pisa G. Galilei Airport), Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. stands out for the complementary nature of the two airports, each with its own specific features: Florence airport focuses on the development of business and leisure traffic through full-service carriers, linking the major European hubs; whereas Pisa airport focuses mainly on tourism traffic operated by low-cost carriers and on cargo flights, paying particular attention to intercontinental connections. The Tuscan Airport System is one of the most important in Italy and is a driver of local economic development in one of the world's best known and most loved regions.
