**TUSCANY AIRPORT SYSTEM:
OVER 900,000 PASSENGERS IN OCTOBER FOR THE FIRST TIME (+6.8%)
Over 8 million passengers already by October 31**

Florence, November 4, 2025 – Toscana Aeroporti set a new monthly record, exceeding the threshold of 900,000 passengers for the first time in October. A total of 934,000 passengers passed through Florence and Pisa airports, an increase of +6.8% compared to October 2024. This result was supported by the positive performance of both traffic segments: international (+8.0%) and domestic (+2.3%). Confirming the positive trend for the year, the **Tuscan Airport System had already exceeded the threshold of 8 million passengers by October 31, 2025**. In the first ten months of the year, 8.6 million passengers passed through the airports, an increase of +8.3% compared to the same period in 2024.

Performance of individual airports:

Florence's Amerigo Vespucci airport had its best October ever, with 373,000 passengers passing through and an improvement of +8.3% compared to October 2024. The significant growth in international traffic (+12.2%) more than offset the decline in domestic traffic (-16.3%). Paris remained the busiest route in October, followed by London, Amsterdam, Barcelona and Munich. In the first ten months of 2025, total traffic at Florence airport, which set records in every single month, exceeded 3.3 million passengers, an increase of +9.4% compared to the same period in 2024.

Pisa's Galileo Galilei airport closed the month - the best October in its history - with 561,000 passengers and an increase of +5.9% compared to 2024. The positive performance was supported by both market segments: international (+4.8%) and domestic (+9.5%). The most popular routes in October were London in first place, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Brussels. As of October 31, 2025, **Pisa airport exceeded the 5 million passenger threshold for the first time**. In fact, it reached 5.3 million passengers in the first ten months of the year, with growth of +7.6% compared to the same period in 2024.
