**TUSCANY AIRPORT SYSTEM:
RECORD NOVEMBER WITH OVER 600,000 PASSENGERS (+10.4%)
*Total passenger numbers for 2024 already exceeded in November***

Florence, December 4, 2025 – Toscana Aeroporti exceeded the threshold of 600,000 passengers for the first time in November. With a total of 613,000 passengers passing through Florence and Pisa airports, it recorded an increase of +10.4% compared to November 2024. The growth in international traffic (+16.6%) more than offset the decline in domestic traffic (-5.8%). As of November 30, 2025, **the Tuscan Airport System had already exceeded the total number of passengers passing through in the whole of 2024**, reaching 9.2 million passengers and an increase of +8.4% on 2024.

Performance of individual airports:

Florence's Amerigo Vespucci airport recorded **its best November ever** with 265,000 passengers passing through, an improvement of +11.6% on 2024. International traffic grew strongly (+17.1%), more than offsetting the decline in domestic traffic (-15.7%). The busiest routes in November were Paris in first place, followed by London, Barcelona, Amsterdam and Madrid. With record figures recorded in every single month of 2025, Florence airport **had already exceeded the total number of passengers passing through in 2024 by November 30, 2025**, with 3.6 million passengers and growth of +9.5% compared to 2024.

Pisa's Galileo Galilei airport had **its best November ever**, with 348,000 passengers passing through and an increase of +9.5% on 2024. The positive performance of the international market segment (+16.1%) more than offset the decline in the domestic market (-2.2%). Tirana ranks first among the most served routes, followed by London, Palermo, Catania and Bari. **As of November 30, 2025, Pisa airport had already exceeded the total number of passengers in 2024**. In fact, there were 5.6 million passengers, an increase of +7.7% compared to the same period in 2024.

The Tuscan Airport System is one of the most important in Italy and is a driver of local economic development in one of the world's best known and most loved regions.
