

**PRESS RELEASE****Traffic growth of 8.4% in 2025.  
New record of 9.8 million passengers**

- *The Tuscan Airport System sets a new passenger record, driven by strong international demand (+8.8%) and domestic demand (+7.4%).*
- *Florence: best year ever with 3.8 million passengers (+9.4%).*
- *Pisa: close to reaching the 6 million mark (+7.8%) with the best result ever, confirming its position as the main gateway to Tuscany.*

*Florence, January 8, 2026* – Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. – a company listed on the Euronext Milan of the Italian Stock Exchange that manages the airports of Florence and Pisa – announces that the Tuscan Airport System closed 2025 with a new all-time traffic record, reaching a total of 9.8 million passengers and growth of +8.4% compared to 2024. This result is the fruit of solid performance in both traffic segments: international traffic grew by +8.8%, while domestic traffic grew by +7.4%. The trend in total aircraft movements was particularly significant, increasing by +7.9%, demonstrating lively market demand and the carriers' full confidence in the capacity of Tuscan airports. The System showed a sustained growth trend, setting records in every single month of the year and exceeding the threshold of one million passengers per month during the summer peak (June, July and August). In December 2025 alone, the Tuscan Airport System handled 610,000 passengers, an increase of +7.8% on the same month in 2024, recording the best December ever for the System.

**Florence's Amerigo Vespucci airport**

The Florence airport closed 2025 with its best ever result: 3.8 million passengers, an improvement of +9.4% on 2024. Growth was driven by international traffic (+12.2%), which accounts for 87.2% of total passengers, confirming the global appeal of Florence and Tuscany as a destination. This performance more than offset the decline in domestic traffic (-6.4%).

- Main connections: Paris, London, Amsterdam, Barcelona, Munich.
- Peak day: 7 September (15,149 passengers).

In December 2025, 237,000 passengers passed through Florence airport, an increase of +7.7% on 2024, a sign that even the last month of the year reached a level never seen before.

**Pisa's Galileo Galilei airport**

Pisa Airport continues its growth trajectory, reaching nearly 6.0 million passengers – its best result ever – with an increase of +7.8% compared to the previous year. The Pisa airport closed 2025 with growth in every month of the year compared to 2024, with consecutive monthly records from February to December. Both the international market segment (+6.3%) and the domestic market segment (+12.8%) contributed to this positive performance, with international traffic accounting for 74.7% of the total. Cargo traffic remained substantially stable, with over 12,400 tonnes of goods and mail, settling at the previous year's levels with a variation of -4.1%.

- Main connections: London, Tirana, Palermo, Catania, Brussels.
- Peak day: 28 June (26,705 passengers).

In December 2025, 373,000 passengers passed through Pisa airport, an increase of +8.1% on 2024, confirming the positive trend with a new monthly record for December.

*“Closing 2025 with a record result of 9.8 million passengers is the clearest demonstration of the vitality and strategic centrality of the Tuscan Airport System. This record result, achieved with growth in every single month of the year in both Florence and Pisa, definitively validates our industrial vision,”* commented **Marco Carrai, Chairman of Toscana Aeroporti**. *“If 2025 was a year of significant growth and decisive steps forward in the authorisation process – such as the positive outcome of the EIA-SEA in Florence – 2026 opens with a clear perspective: to transform these traffic volumes into structural value. The urgency of completing the planned infrastructure investments, from the expansion of the Pisa terminal to the implementation of the Florence Masterplan, is no longer just a strategic objective, but a necessary response to a demand for mobility that our region is expressing strongly and that we are ready to meet with efficiency and sustainability, while generating a concrete positive impact for the region.”*
