

**PRESS RELEASE****TOSCANA AEROPORTI: OVER 700,000 PASSENGERS FOR THE FIRST TIME  
IN MARCH (+9.3%)**

*Florence, April 3, 2026* – In March, the Tuscan Airport System comprising Florence and Pisa recorded over 700,000 passengers for the first time, representing a 9.3% increase compared with 2025. This performance was driven by growth in the international traffic segment (+12.3%), which offset the decline in the domestic segment (-0.8%).

The Tuscan Airport System, with traffic volumes rising in each of the three months, handled a total of 1.7 million passengers in the first quarter of the year, an increase of 7.1% compared to 2025.

**Performance of individual airports:**

Florence's "Amerigo Vespucci" airport recorded a record-breaking result for the month of March, with over 295,000 passengers passing through and a 9.4% increase compared with the same month in 2025. The international traffic segment saw a 13.3% increase, offsetting the 12.1% decline in the domestic segment. Paris remains the busiest route, followed by London, Barcelona, Madrid and Amsterdam. The Florence airport, with monthly volumes exceeding those of the corresponding months of the previous year, had already surpassed the 700,000-passenger mark by March 31, 2026, representing a 7.4% increase on 2025.

Pisa's "Galileo Galilei" airport recorded over 400,000 passengers for the first time in March, with a 9.3% increase compared to 2025. Positive results were seen in both market segments: international (+11.3%) and domestic (+3.4%). In the ranking of routes with the highest traffic volume, Tirana remains in first place, followed by London, Palermo, Catania and Bari. Pisa airport surpassed the one-million-passenger mark as early as the first quarter of the year, with a 7.0% increase compared to 2025.
