

PRESS RELEASE**TOSCANA AEROPORTI: TRAFFIC CONTINUES TO GROW IN APRIL
WITH 958,000 PASSENGERS (+6.4%)**

Florence, May 6, 2026 – The Tuscan Airport System continued to grow in April as well. A total of 958,000 passengers passed through Florence and Pisa airports, representing a 6.4% increase compared with 2025. This growth was driven by the international traffic segment, which rose by 8.2%, offsetting the slight decline in the domestic segment (-0.6%).

The Tuscan Airport System, having delivered record results in every single month of 2026, reached a total of 2.7 million passengers in the first four months of the year, an increase of +6.9% compared to 2025.

Performance of individual airports:

Florence's "Amerigo Vespucci" airport reached a new all-time high in April, with 383,000 passengers passing through and an increase of +8.8% compared with 2025. Positive results were recorded in both market segments: international (+10.0%) and domestic (+0.4%). In April, Paris remained the busiest route for the Florence airport, followed by London, Amsterdam, Barcelona and Rome. Florence airport, having set records in every single month of 2026, exceeded 1.1 million passengers in the first four months of the year, marking a 7.9% increase compared with 2025.

Pisa's "Galileo Galilei" airport handled 575,000 passengers in April, its best result ever, with an increase of +4.8% compared to the same month in 2025. The international traffic segment, up by +6.9%, more than offset the 0.9% decline in the domestic segment. London takes first place in the ranking of routes with the highest traffic volume, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Paris and Catania. In the first four months of the year, Pisa airport handled a total of 1.6 million passengers, setting a new all-time high, with an increase of +6.2% compared with 2025.
