

PRESS RELEASE**8.2 MILLION PASSENGERS HANDLED IN 2023,
WITH A 21.8% INCREASE ON 2022 AND A 99.1% RECOVERY ON 2019, A RECORD
YEAR FOR TOSCANA AEROPORTI**

Florence, January 11, 2024 – In 2023, the Tuscan Airport System handled 8,187,603 passengers overall, with a +21.8% increase on 2022 and a 99.1% recovery compared to 2019 (pre-Covid), a record year for Toscana Aeroporti. The number of flights grew compared to 2022 (+13.1%), as did the load factor (+3.6 pps), which rose from 80.1% in 2022 to 83.7% in 2023.

In 2023, the Tuscan Airport System reported all-time records in terms of monthly passenger traffic in July, August, September and October. A total of 947,497 passengers were handled in July 2023, which stood out as the best month ever in the Tuscan Airport System's history.

Pisa Galileo Galilei airport

With 5,109,682 passengers handled in 2023, Pisa airport's passenger traffic grew by +13.7% compared to 2022 and recovered by 94.8% on the 2019 pre-Covid year. The traffic increase reported in 2023 was confirmed by the uptrend in total flights (+5.9%) and in the load factor (86.3%; +4.7 pps). International passenger traffic grew in 2023 (+23.3% on 2022), whereas the national component declined (-8.7%), within a context where international traffic accounted for 74.4% of total traffic. The ranking of the 2023 most popular destinations was led by London and Tirana at international level, followed by Palermo and Catania as national destinations.

Florence Amerigo Vespucci airport

Florence Airport hit an all-time record in 2023, exceeding 3 million passengers for the first time. With 3,077,921 passengers handled, Florence airport grew by +38.1% compared to 2022 and by +7.1% on the 2019 pre-Covid year. The increase compared to 2022 was driven by the performance in terms of total flights (+21.8%) and of the load factor (79.8%; +2.4 pps). In 2023, national passenger traffic grew (+170.2%), as did international traffic (+28.2%), within a context where international traffic accounted for 85.9% of total traffic. The top five most popular destinations among Florence airport's passengers in 2023, all served by international flights, were Paris, London, Amsterdam, Barcelona and Zurich.

Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. is the management company of the Florence and Pisa airports. Founded on 1 June 2015 through the merger of AdF - Aeroporto di Firenze S.p.A. (managing company of the Florence A. Vespucci airport) and SAT - Società Aeroporto Toscano S.p.A. (managing company of the Pisa G. Galilei Airport), Toscana Aeroporti S.p.A. stands out for the complementary nature of the two airports, each with its own specific features: Florence airport focuses on the development of business and leisure traffic through full-service carriers, linking the major European hubs; whereas Pisa airport focuses mainly on tourism traffic operated by low-cost carriers and on cargo flights, paying particular attention to intercontinental connections. The Tuscan Airport System is one of the most important in Italy and is a driver of local economic development in one of the world's best known and most loved regions.
