

PRESS RELEASE**The record growth trend of the Tuscan Airport System continues:
best October ever with 874 thousand passengers**

Florence, November 5, 2024 – The record trend of the **Tuscan Airport System** continues, recording its best October month ever with 874 thousand passengers and a 6.0% growth compared to the same month in 2023. The month's results were positively influenced by both the increase in commercial passenger flight movements (+3.8%) and the load factor of scheduled flights (+1.6 percentage points, equal to 83.6%). The Tuscan Airport System reached its historical maximum in the first ten months of the year with 7.9 million passengers transited and a 10.1% increase over the same period in 2023.

Florence's Amerigo Vespucci airport reports a record month with 344 thousand passengers transited, marking a 10.8% growth over 2023. The result is supported by the improvement over 2023 in the number of commercial passenger flights (+7.4%) and aircraft load factor (+1.8 percentage points, equal to 81.2%). The month shows strong growth in both international passenger traffic (+11.1%) and domestic traffic (+9.8%). In the ranking of destinations most appreciated by scheduled flight passengers in October 2024, Paris ranks first, followed by London, Amsterdam, Rome, and Barcelona. Florence airport, with monthly records registered in every single month of the year, has surpassed the threshold of 3 million passengers for the first time already at the end of the first ten months of the year, recording an overall growth of 14.8% over 2023.

Best October month ever also for **Pisa's Galileo Galilei airport**, which reaches 530 thousand transited passengers (+3.1% compared to the same month in 2023). The result stems from the increase compared to 2023 in both load factor (+1.7 percentage points, equal to 85.2%) and the number of commercial passenger flights (+0.6%). In October 2024, there is also growth in both international commercial traffic (+3.5%) and domestic traffic (+4.2%). In the ranking of preferred destinations for Pisa airport passengers, we find London, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania, and Paris. Pisa airport marks its best result ever in the first ten months of the year, reaching 4.9 million transited passengers and recording a 7.4% growth over the same period in 2023.
