

PRESS RELEASE**March record with over 600,000 passengers (+11.2%)**

Florence, April 3, 2025 – Historic goal for Toscana Aeroporti, which in March exceeded the 600 thousand passenger threshold for the first time. In detail, the airports of Florence and Pisa recorded a total of 641 thousand transits, marking an improvement of 11.2% compared to 2024. Solid growth was recorded in March for both domestic (+23.0%) and international (+8.2%) commercial traffic. Thanks to the best-ever results in every single month, the first quarter of 2025 saw 1.6 million passengers pass through, an increase of 10.3% over the same period in 2024.

Florence's "Amerigo Vespucci" airport posted a record March with 269,000 passengers and a 13.1% increase over the same month in 2024. Strong progress for both the international (+13.8%) and domestic (+10.8%) commercial traffic segments. In the ranking of the preferred routes for travellers departing from the Florence airport we find Paris in first place, followed by London, Rome, Barcelona and Amsterdam. The first quarter of 2025 represents a record period for the Florence airport which, with the best monthly performance ever recorded in the first three months of the year, reaches 674 thousand passengers, an increase of 7.9% over the same period in 2024.

March was also the best March ever for Pisa's 'Galileo Galilei' airport, which reached 372 thousand passengers and grew by 9.8% compared to March 2024. This positive variation is driven by both the robust increase in domestic (+28.2%) and international (+3.8%) commercial traffic. In March, London was confirmed as the route most used by passengers at Pisa airport, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Paris. With 958,000 passengers in the first quarter of 2025, Pisa airport set its best result ever with a 12.1% increase over the same period in 2024.

(managing company of the Florence A. Vespucci airport) and SAT - Società Aeroporto Toscano S.p.A. (managing company of the Pisa G. The Tuscan Airport System is one of the most important in Italy and is a driver of local economic development in one of the world's best known and most loved regions.
