## Another record month for Toscana Aeroporti Passengers exceeded 900 thousand in April with a growth of +11.1%

Florence, May 7, 2025 – April was a record April for Toscana Aeroporti, which exceeded 900,000 passengers in total transiting through the Florence and Pisa airports with an increase of 11.1% compared to 2024. Both the domestic (+14.7%) and international (+10.2%) commercial traffic segments grew in April. With the best results ever recorded in every single month of 2025, the 2.5 million passenger threshold was already exceeded in the first four months of the year with a 10.6% increase over the same period in 2024.

Another record month for Florence's "Amerigo Vespucci" airport with 352,000 passengers passing through in April and a 10.3% growth over the same month in 2024. The sustained increase in the international commercial traffic segment (+13.2%) more than offset the drop in the domestic segment (-6.9%). The preferred routes for travellers leaving from the Florence airport in April saw Paris in first place, followed by London, Amsterdam, Barcelona and Frankfurt. The Florence airport exceeded 1 million passengers for the first time in the first four months of the year, recording an increase of 8.7% over the same period in 2024.

In April, the Pisa's 'Galileo Galilei' airport broke through the 500 thousand passenger threshold for the first time, reaching 548 thousand passengers and recording an improvement of 11.6% over the same month in 2024. The positive variation is driven by the robust increase in both domestic (+23.7%) and international (+8.0%) commercial traffic. In April London confirmed itself as the route most used by passengers at Pisa airport, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Brussels. In the first four months of the year 1.5 million passengers transited through Pisa airport, the best result ever, with an increase of 11.9% over the same period in 2024.
