In June, the 1 million passenger threshold was exceeded for the first time (+7.1%). Over 4.5 million in the first half of the year.

Florence, July 3, 2025 - In June 2025, the Tuscan airports of Florence and Pisa surpassed the 1 million passenger threshold for the first time, handling a total of about 1.02 million passengers, an increase of 7.1% compared to June 2024. The performance was sustained by both the international segment (+7.4%) and the domestic segment (+5.1%). The cumulative figures for the first six months of the year stood at over 4.5 million passengers, up 9.7% on the first half of 2024, marking a new record for the period.

Below are the details of the traffic data for the individual airports.

Florence 'Amerigo Vespucci' airport contributed to the result with over 390 thousand passengers, up 9.4% and marking the best June ever for the airport. Also worth mentioning is the peak in daily traffic recorded on June 15, 2025 with about 14,900 passengers. International traffic showed a significant acceleration (+12.9%), against a drop in the domestic segment (-10.2%). The main destinations by traffic volume were, in order, Paris, London, Amsterdam, Barcelona and Munich. The first half of 2025 closed for Florence airport with a record of over 1.8 million passengers (+9.2%).

Pisa's "Galileo Galilei" airport closed the month of June with about 630,000 passengers, up 5.7%, marking the best month of June ever for the Pisan airport as well, with the threshold of 600,000 passengers being exceeded for the first time. A record day was also recorded here on June 28, 2025 with a peak of about 26,200 passengers. The dynamics of both traffic components, domestic (+10.9%) and international (+3.8%), were positive. The ranking of the most frequented routes sees London in first place, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Paris. The total number of passengers since the beginning of the year has thus set a new record of around 2.73 million, an increase of 10.0% compared to the first six months of 2024.
